Q: What is the Pro Tools Certified Operator exam?

A: Pro Tools Operator Certification will empower you with the skills you need to make the most of your Pro Tools system in a Music and/or Post Production environment. As a professional, an Avid Certified credential allows you to:

- Differentiate yourself from competitors
- Make your résumé stand out
- Attract and win new business
- Gain recognition from your employer and peers

Q: How do I become a Pro Tools Operator?

A: To become a Certified Pro Tools Operator you must complete all Pro Tools 100-, and 200-level curriculum and course projects/exercises.

Q: Will my certification expire?

A: Pro Tools Certification does not expire. You become certified for a particular version of Pro Tools software. Then, Certified Pro Tools Operators and Experts have an option to update their certification by taking the update course and exam.

Q: How do I take the exam?

A: Once you have achieved User Level Certification, you are eligible to take the Pro Tools Operator Exam. The Pro Tools Operator Exam is delivered electronically by Center for Pro Tools. Exams are scheduled by appointment once required classes are completed. To take the exam you must:

- Complete all Pro Tools 100-, and 200-level courses
- Complete all course projects and exercises
- Pass each course completion exam
- Pass the final Pro Tools Operator certification exam
