Q: Why should I pursue VENUE Certification?

A: Simply put, VENUE certification demonstrates your desire to lead the industry, not follow. VENUE is a revolutionary line of digital live sound systems that deliver amazing sound quality, reliability, flexibility, and ease-of-use. Designed with direct input from leading mix engineers, VENUE brings innovation and intuitive workflows to live mixing-answering the complexities of today's live sound applications while empowering efficiency and creativity. No other digital sound system comes close.

Q: Do I need to be Pro Tools Certified to become VENUE Certified?

A: No. However, VENUE offers the most streamlined, reliable, and economical approach to integrating Pro Tools' multitrack recording and playback into a live production environment, so a dual certification can be beneficial. With an HDx or FWx Option Card installed, you can connect a computer running Pro Tools HD® or Pro Tools LE® software to the VENUE system through the card. Then record every single input from the stage-up to 128 tracks with Pro Tools|HD, or up to 24 tracks with Pro Tools LE-without the need for additional interfaces or splits.

Q: How do I take the exam?

A: To become a Certified VENUE Operator, you must schedule an exam once required classes and hands-on exercises have been completed. The VENUE Operator Exam is delivered electronically. To take the exam you must:

- Complete all VENUE 100- and 200-level courses and course projects/exercises
